The central tenet of the High/Scope approach is "active learning" – the belief that children learn best through active experiences with people, materials, events, and ideas rather than through direct teaching or sequenced exercises.

Not only do students learn basic skills such as letters, colors, numbers, and shapes, but they also learn higher order thinking skills like following rules, making good choices, solving conflicts, critical thinking, and making judgements.
